

Creative Party Flair Privacy Policy

1. We respect your privacy
 - 1.1 Creative Party Flair respects your right to privacy and is committed to safeguarding the privacy of our customers. We adhere to the Australian Privacy Principles contained in the Privacy Act 1988 (Cth). This policy sets out how we treat your personal information.
 - 1.2 'Personal information' is information we hold which is identifiable as being about you.
2. Collection of personal information
 - 2.1 You may provide basic information such as your name, phone number, address and email address to enable us to send information, provide updates and process your product or service order. We may collect additional information you provide while interacting with us.
3. How we collect your personal information
 - 3.1 Creative Party Flair collects personal information from you in several ways, including when you interact with us electronically or in person and when we provide services to you. We may receive personal information from third parties. If this happens, we will protect it as set out in this Privacy Policy.
4. Use of your personal information
 - 4.1 Creative Party Flair may use personal information collected from you to provide you with information, updates and our services. We may also make you aware of new and additional products, service and opportunities that are available to you. We may use your personal information to improve our products and services to better understand your requirements.
 - 4.2 Creative Party Flair may contact you by a variety of ways including telephone, email, sms or mail.
5. Disclosure of your personal information
 - 5.1 We may disclose your personal information to any employees, officers, insurers, professional advisors, agents, suppliers or sub-contractors only if deemed necessary for the purposes set out in this Privacy Policy. Personal information is only supplied to a third party when it is required for the delivery of services.
 - 5.2 We may need to disclose personal information to comply with a legal requirement, such as a law, regulation, court order, subpoena, warrant, during a legal proceeding or in response to a law enforcement agency request now and again.
 - 5.3 We may also use your personal information to protect the legal rights, property or safety of Creative Party Flair, its customers and third parties.

If there is a change of control in our business or a sale or transfer of business assets, we reserve the right to transfer to the extent permissible at law our user databases, together with any personal information and non-personal information contained in those databases. This information may be disclosed to a potential purchaser under an agreement to maintain confidentiality. We would seek to only disclose information on good faith and where required by any of the above circumstances.
 - 5.4 By providing us with personal information, you consent to the terms of this Privacy Policy and types of disclosure covered by this Privacy Policy. Where we disclose your personal

information to third parties, we will request that the third party follow this Privacy Policy regarding handling your personal information.

6. Security of your personal information

6.1 Creative Party Flair is committed to ensuring that the information you provide to us is secure. In order to prevent unauthorised access or disclosure we use physical, electronic and managerial procedures to safeguard and secure information and protect it from misuse, interference, loss and unauthorised access, modification and disclosure.

6.2 The transmission and exchange of information is carried out at your own risk. We cannot guarantee the security of any information that you transmit to us or receive from us. Although we take every measure to safeguard against unauthorised disclosures of information, we cannot assure you that personal information that we collect will not be disclosed in a manner that is inconsistent with this Privacy Policy.

7. Access to your personal information

7.1 You may request details of personal information that we hold of you in accordance with the provisions of the Privacy Act 1988 (Cth).

8.2 Any photograph's taken of children and adults will not be used in social media sites unless our photograph consent form is signed.
